



Some residents of Maywood and Cherrydale have recommended that the developer of the new condominiums (you can see the excavation for the new structure in the background of this photo) use the existing water pipe in the median strip to supply water to a proposed fountain located to the right of the light pole in this photograph.



# Upcoming books for the adult group:

Monday, Oct. 17. **Note the date, please.** The book is *Priceless: How I Went Undercover to Rescue the World's Stolen Treasures*, by Robert K. Wittman, founder of the FBI's Art Crime Team. Published in 2010, this book received an Amazon reader rating of 4.5 out of a possible 5.

Monday, Nov. 14. *Pride and Prejudice*, by Jane Austen. First published in 1813, this book has remained a readers' favorite for nearly two centuries. It has also been a favorite of film-makers, through its most ardent fans usually say that no film has done it justice. Jonathan Yardley, the *Washington Post*'s book reviewer, claimed in July 2009 that the book was worth any reader's time.

Monday, Dec. 12. *Pearl Buck in China: Journey to The Good Earth*, by Hilary Spurling. This was one of the more notable nonfiction books of 2010. It covers the life of a masterful writer who was a keen observer of China before World War II.


